You can use the 'Square' mode on your phone camera. The US Department of State also has a [photo cropping tool](#) to resize your photo to the correct dimensions. You will submit the passport photo by emailing it to overseas@lclark.edu.
- ☐ Unofficial Transcript
 - Students can download their unofficial transcripts for free in [WebAdvisor](#).
 - The unofficial transcript should be submitted via email to overseas@lclark.edu.
 - *First-Year/Transfer Students*: Submit your current course enrollment as found in [WebAdvisor](#). Transfer students may submit an unofficial transcript from their previous institution.
