



Hi, new student!

The residential component of the L&C experience is an exciting step toward building your community—from finding out who your roommate is to the residence hall that will help shape your first year on campus.

The [housing application](#)—which includes a contract, housing preference, roommate questionnaire, and meal plan selection—is open from **May 12–June 16**. But before you can access the housing app, there are some tasks you are required to complete on the New Student Checklist, including [creating your L&C account and email](#). (Note that it can take up to 24 hours after account creation to access the housing portal.)

You can also apply to live in a [Living-Learning Community](#) (LLC) where you are able to establish relationships with peers, faculty, and departments through a shared interest, such as environmental action, outdoor pursuits, fine arts, and more. [LLC applications](#) are separate from the general housing application and open May 12–June 16.

Residential Accommodations

The [Office of Student Accessibility](#) will work with new students on disability accommodations related to academic support, housing, service/emotional support animals, parking, and meal plans. The [Center for Spiritual Life](#) will work with new students on religious accommodations related to housing and meal plans. Placement into accommodation housing for the fall semester cannot be guaranteed if the accommodation process is completed after June 16.
