Hi, new student!

It's time to start thinking ahead to your fall classes. This week, we want to offer a big-picture look at course registration and how you can get any support you need through the process.

Also, ☐ . . . keep reading for your Words or Numbers placement!

When will registration happen?

Registration happens in two rounds on **July 30** and **August 1**. On July 30, you'll register for one top-priority class, and on August 1, you'll register for the rest of your fall classes.

Do I need to register for my Words or Numbers class?

No, you are already registered for your [First-Year Seminar](#) (Words or Numbers) class, which is currently unassigned. You can see more details about the placement on your [Hive student portal](#)!

How does registration work?

You will [register for your classes](#) using WebAdvisor. Your college advisor, who you can find in your student portal, is available to help via email and Zoom, both during the days of registration and in the weeks leading up to it! We highly recommend you **connect with your advisor as soon as possible** to talk through the mechanics of class registration and to plan your fall class schedule.

What should I be doing right now?

- Start brainstorming which classes you'd like to take using the College Advising Center's [Getting Started in a Major or Minor page](#). This page lists every program we offer along with suggested first-year courses.
- [Schedule an appointment with your advisor](#), who you can find in your student portal, if you haven't already done so! Don't wait until the last minute to meet with them, as their calendars can get booked up.
- Save the date for our [registration webinar](#) on **July 22**.
