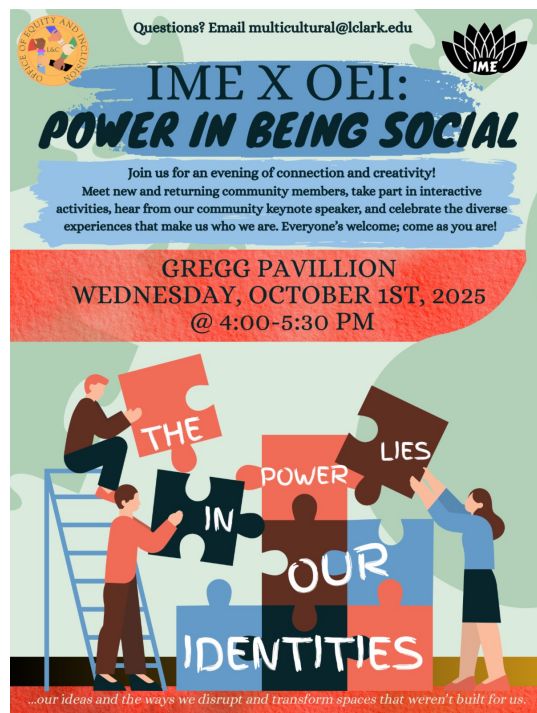
## First - Gen Imposter Syndrome Workshop

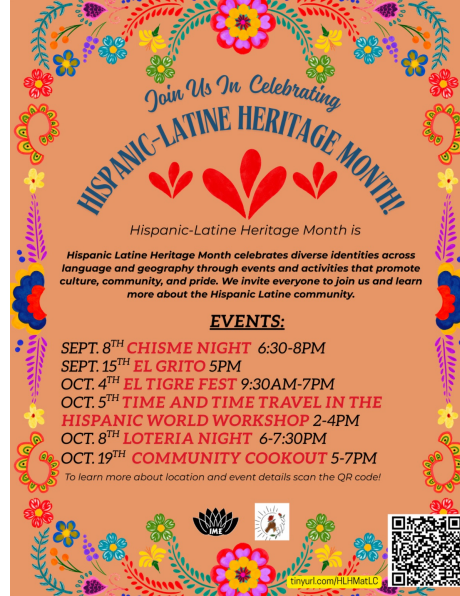

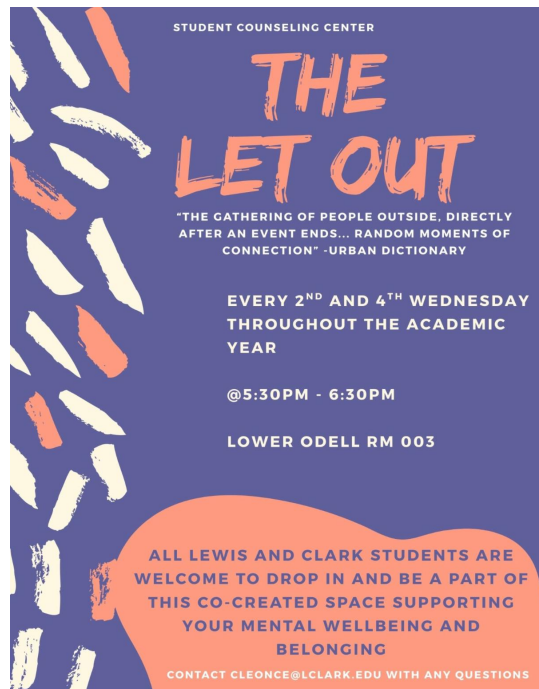
